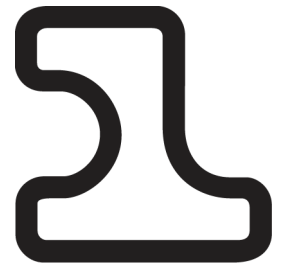

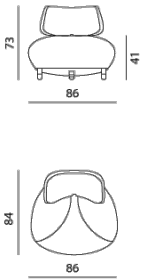

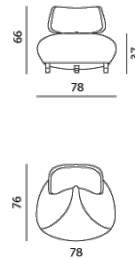

Seat Plate material.

Back

Laminated beechwood.

Springs

Elastic webbing.

Padding

Seat 10 cm PU-Moulded foam sg 50 kg/m³ Leoskin covering.

Back 4 cm PU-Moulded foam sg 50 kg/m³ Leoskin covering.

Legs/tube

Chrome.

Feet

Synthetic in standard black.

The central strip and the other parts of the seat (side and rear) are available in different colours. These combinations are only possible with one variety of leather.
